- a) Team members in theatre should always be kept to the minimum required
- b) Aerosol generating procedures:
  - a. Intubation and extubation should be undertaken with only essential staff present. The scrub team should stay in the sterile scrub area in T2 theatre, until the intubation procedure is completed
  - b. Diathermy is considered an AGP, therefore its use should be severely restricted and only used when absolutely essential. FFP3 masks will need to be worn when diathermy is in use.
- c) Surgical masks:
  - a. Must be tight-fitting and cover both nose and mouth
  - b. Must not be allowed to dangle around the neck after or between each use
  - c. Must not be touched once put on
  - d. Must be changed when they become moist or damaged
  - e. Can be worn for a session when managing different patients, and then discarded as clinical waste hand hygiene must be performed after disposal
- d) Gloves must be changed when moving from a dirty to a clean task. Removes gloves (if double gloved, remove outer pair to wash gloved hand), wash hands and put on pair of clean gloves, ensuring that the cuffs of the gloves cover the cuffs of the gown.
- e) Sessional use means for the duration of the shift. Only change if breached or breaks taken.
