
## **COVID-19 Obstetric Assessment Admission Pathway**

All other women with moderate symptoms of COVID-19 should access 111 online

Women who have respiratory difficulties should call 999

## EVERY PATIENT THAT ATTENDS OR TELEPHONES THE UNIT MUST BE ASKED:

- 1. Do you have a high temperature?
- 2. Do you have a new continuous cough?
- 3. Are you self-isolating because someone in your house is symptomatic?



## IF PRESENTING UNANNOUNCED

- 1. Provide a facemask for BOTH the woman and her partner
- 2. These masks must be worn at all times
- 3. Immediately transfer them BOTH to the closest available isolated room
- 4. Advise they MUST stay in this room
- 5. Contact Delivery suite Co-ordinator to arrange for patient to be admitted to T2

A staff member will collect the patient wearing PPE and transfer them to an isolation room in T2 via Tertiary block lift

## **OVER THE PHONE**

If admission is needed advise the woman:

- 1. Attend the unit with one asymptomatic person only
- 2. Park in the designated area outside ANC
- 3. Wait in the car on arrival and phone delivery suite again
- 4. A staff member (wearing PPE) will collect the patient and provide BOTH the woman and partner with a mask
- 5. These masks must be worn at all times

The woman and partner will be transferred to isolation room on T2 via Tertiary block lift
